

Supply List for Hand Painting Fabric with Transparent Dyes

July 30th 9 AM at BHCC

H-H will supply the dye paints; we will be using Pebeo Transparent Paints like Mickey Lawler of "Skydyes" fame. I will be using her techniques. Please wear clothing that you don't care about as the dyes are permanent.

You will need:

1. A large piece of foam core board covered with clear Contact adhesive backed or clear plastic sheeting available at Homosassa WalMart fabric dept. by the foot. Use the thinnest version.
2. several inexpensive foam brushes of different sizes, no larger than 3" or smaller than 1".
3. Three or four shallow plastic trays or deep lids from your recyclables. You can use the inexpensive throw away plastic storage containers or clear plastic lids from bakery items. These are for mixing paint colors in.
4. A plant mister bottle with a fine spray or an adjustable one.
5. PFD fabric (prepared for dyeing) from Tomorrow's Treasures. If you buy a yard you will have enough for several paintings. The painting part doesn't take long but they need to sun dry in between. I will provide pieces of scrap fabric for testing your colors.
